PLEASE NOTE:

1. Only one horse & rider combination, and one level, per report form.
2. This form and all score sheets (or USDF score reports) must be POSTMARKED or EMAILED (scanned copies of the test and/or USDF Score Report) no later than **December 1, 2023** (scores can be earned from January 1 to November 30, 2023).
3. Whether sending or emailing, include a good quality copy (or scan) of the front sheet of your test showing the score and this form. Or the USDF score report
4. Receipt will be acknowledged by email. If you would prefer, you can send a self-addressed stamped postcard with your scores. NEWDA is not responsible for scores lost in the mail. Members may use delivery confirmation through the US Post Office, but PLEASE DO NOT send via certified mail.

1. In-Hand Awards: Two scores from two different judges from two different shows.
2. Scores must be earned at NEWDA recognized schooling show and/or USEF/USDF recognized show, open to all breeds.
3. At least one score must be submitted from a show held in Wisconsin.
4. One test score must be from the highest test of that level (example: for Introductory Level, the highest test is Intro C).
5. Maiden division awards may be from any test of that level.
