'All Breeds welcome (including gaited as "gait" is synonymous with "trot" on any test).

ENTER BY MAIL: Pre-paid entries must be postmarked by closing date to avoid late fee. ENTER BY E-MAIL: Entries must be made by closing date to avoid late fee. Payment must be received by the last day of show. LATE ENTRIES: Must be e-mailed by close of Friday start date. Payment plus late fee must be received by the last day of the show.

No refund or show credit if rider(s) or horse(s) unable to compete, scratch any test after show's closing date or submit incorrect test video.

Entries will receive an email confirmation by show chair by the start of the show.

Test must be video'd within the 10 days of the show. All Dressage test follow category rules. Use any recording device, ensure sound is also recorded. The better quality video helps the judges watch your test, and zooming in is acceptable, just don't get too close. No editing of video allowed, video the rider as they enter the arena until they are exiting the arena. Riders may have readers for the test, but no coaching during test is allowed.

Post video to You Tube, unpublished. Email video test link & scratches by show's deadline at 11:00pm Sunday, May 5, June 9, Sept. 15, Oct. 13, Nov. 10 to the show chair.

Allow 10 days for results to be posted to NEWDA's website & NEWDA Southern Chapter facebook group and riders e-mail. Ribbons and Score sheets will be mailed.

All who participated will receive video links to all tests ridden after each show's results are posted.'

Artisan 1-5 placement ribbons per division. (some classes may be combined) Show High Score ribbon if category has min. of (5) entries (regardless of test/division): Team Dressage test excluded.

Show Versatility Champion & Reserve ribbon awarded if show has min. of 3 participants who each compete in 3 different categories, Traditional, Western, Working Equitation, In-hand or Trail. Freestyle & Team Dressage test excluded. 3 test will be averaged for total versatility score.

Show's overall High Score and Reserve ribbon awarded to participant with the highest scoring test.

To Enter in Championship Show, participants must compete in two Virtual shows, same category.

One USDF/USEF/WDA Virtual score may be submitted with two live scores for the state NEWDA year-end awards; NEWDA Southern Chapter In-hand, Trail and Freestyle do not qualify.
